

The Boi Bumbá festival is held in Brazil. It is a very big festival. Boi Bumbá festivals take place throughout the Amazon region, but the one in the city of Parintins on Tupinam Island is the biggest and locals say the best.



Two teams compete to tell the legend of Catrina, her husband Chico and an ox that was killed and brought back to life by magic. The three – day open air festival presents six different performances, each a thrilling mix of dance, song, drama, parade, floats and puppets.

Christ the redeemer is a statue of Jesus Christ, located in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, at the top of Mount Corcovado. is listed as one of the New Seven Wonders of the World. It's also a symbol of Christianity across the planet. It took nine years to build the statue.

The statue has been hit by lightning numerous times. Just before the World Cup in 2014, a lightning strike damaged the back of the head and tip of a finger, which had to be repaired quickly before the games began.

There is a chapel at the base of the statue. The chapel is named after Brazil's patron saint.





Angel falls is the world's highest waterfall it is a waterfall in Venezuela. It is 79 metres and a plunge of 807 m. The waterfall drops over the edge of the Auyán-tepui mountain.

Angel Falls is three times as tall as Paris landmark, the Eiffel Tower.

During warmer and drier seasons, the water of Angel Falls evaporates even before it touches the ground, forming a mist.

During the rainy season they may divide into two separate waterfalls. When the water level is high it is possible to feel the spray up to a 1,5 kilometer(1 mile) away.

The waterfall has been known as the “Angel Falls” since the Mid-20th century; they are named after Jimmie Angel, a US aviator, who was the first person to fly over the falls.





Machu Picchu

Machu Picchu is a historical place in Peru .It is an Incan citadel set high in the Andes Mountains in Peru, above the Urubamba River valley. Built in the 15th century and later abandoned, it is renowned for its sophisticated dry-stone walls that fuse huge blocks.





Pilpintuwasi Butterfly Farm

Pilpintuwasi Butterfly farm is an Amazonian Butterfly Farm and Animal Rescue Centre.
It rescues animals and brings them back to the centre.






The Galapagos Islands

It is a popular tourist attraction


